MEETING MINUTES MONTHLY TOWN BOARD MEETING

Tuesday, March 9th, 2021 6:30 pm

Town of Wagner Town Hall, W2379 County Road JJ, Wausaukee

Attendance: Chairperson Steve Renikow Sr., Supervisors Mollie Arthur and Ed Delfosse,
Treasurer Margo Renikow, Clerk Cassie Brown and 12 members of the public.

1. **Call to order – attendance sign in. Called to order by Chairperson Steve Renikow Sr. at 6:27PM.**
2. **Pledge of Allegiance was said.**
3. **Approve agenda. Motion to approve Delfosse/Arthur.**
4. **Correspondence. None.**
5. **Board updates. None.**
6. **Public input – Speakers will be limited to 5 minutes.**
 - a. **Sam Marzahl questioned if the Town could open County trails in the Town of Wagner for ATV usage. He stated there is a form and the Town Board would have to present this request to the County. Chairperson Steve Renikow Sr. stated it would be on the agenda for next month.**
7. **Discuss/Consider February 10th, 2021 monthly meeting minutes, action if any. Motion to approve Arthur/Delfosse.**
8. **Discussion only Treasurer’s report ending February 28th, 2021. Treasurer Margo Renikow discussed the Town’s ending cash balances.**
9. **Budget adjustments / transfers. Treasurer Margo Renikow stated \$520,000 was transferred from the Money Market account to Checking to cover disbursements and property taxes paid to Marinette County, NWTC and Wausaukee School.**
10. **Fire Department updates. Mike Caylor stated there were four calls since the last meeting. Two were MABAS calls for structure fires in the Town of Lake and Menominee-Ingallston. The other two calls were for snowmobile accidents. 50 hours for training and maintenance were**

held, and the extractor is here and ready for use. Burning permits will be required once the snow is gone. Camp fires are fine if burning fire wood, but any waste or debris will require a permit. Household paper is also considered debris burn. There are two ways to obtain a burning permit. Please visit DNR.WI.GOV and use the keyword FIRE, or call 1-888-947-2876 (WISBURN). A meat raffle will be held at the Heritage on March 27th, 2021 from Noon to 3:00PM.

11. **Public Works updates.** Jimmy Brown stated the road restriction signs will be going up by the end of the week.
12. **Animal Control updates.** None.
13. **Action Items, action if any:**
 - a. **Discuss/consider local Town road improvement program funding.** Chairperson Steve Renikow Sr. met with County and there is \$26,113.02 available for use towards road repair. The funds were originally designated for Broennenberg Rd. in 2017, so the work has to be performed on that road. The distance would be one mile going East from Four Lakes Road. If the Town wants to apply for the funding the work would have to be placed for bids. One culvert would also have to be replaced, and this job is estimated to cost \$167,000. Motion to approve bids and apply for funding Arthur/Delfosse.
 - b. **Discuss/consider weight restrictions on Town roads.** Restrictions will mirror Marinette County and signs will be up by the end of the week.
14. **Future agenda items.**
 - a. **ATV usage on County roads in the Town of Wagner.**
15. **Discuss / consider processing current and outstanding vouchers.**
