## MEETING MINUTES

### MONTHLY TOWN BOARD MEETING

Wednesday, May 11<sup>th</sup>, 2022 6:30 pm

Town of Wagner Town Hall, W2379 County Road JJ, Wausauke

Attendance: Chairperson Steve Renikow Sr., Supervisors Mollie Arthur and Ed Delfosse, Clerk Cassie Brown, Treasurer Margo Renikow and 10 members of the public.

1. **Call to order – attendance sign in. Called to order by Chairperson Steve Renikow Sr. at 6:28PM.**
2. **Pledge of Allegiance was said.**
3. **Approve agenda. Motion to approve Delfosse/Arthur.**
4. **Correspondence. Clerk Cassie Brown stated post cards were received by Secure Democracy USA and the League of Women Voters thanking the poll workers and community for their participation in elections.**
5. **Board updates. None.**
6. **Public input – Speakers will be limited to 5 minutes.**
  - a. **Howie Anderson requested a price increase from \$62.50 to \$70.00 per hour for cutting the Town’s grass. This will be on the agenda next month.**
  - b. **Dave Doberstein requested the Town to keep an eye on Tabor Cemetery. He found 4-wheeler marks tearing up the grounds within the cemetery.**
7. **Discuss/Consider April 12<sup>th</sup>, 2022 monthly meeting minutes, action if any. Motion to approve Arthur/Delfosse.**
8. **Discussion only Treasurer’s report ending April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022. Treasurer Margo Renikow discussed the Town’s ending cash balances.**
9. **Budget adjustments / transfers. None.**
10. **Fire Department updates. Mike Caylor stated 4 calls were made since the last meeting. 2 were for wild land fires, 1 roll over and 1 MABAS call with the Town of Peshtigo. 104 hours were spent on maintenance and training.**

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11. **Public Works updates.** Chairperson Steve Renikow Sr. stated grating will begin next week.
12. **Animal Control updates.** Jerry Micksch stated one call was received from Supervisor Ed Delfosse regarding a dog on Snyder Road. The dog had no tags and was taken to the animal shelter. Also, the Town has to determine a procedure for injured animals with no tags and Marinette County will follow this procedure if dispatched. This will be on the agenda next month.
13. **Action Items, action if any:**
  - a. **Discuss/consider Old Depot demolition / legal action.** Supervisor Mollie Arthur stated there are no updates.
  - b. **Discuss/consider reading of the Lake Mary ordinance.** Chairperson Steve Renikow Sr. read the ordinance to the public.
  - c. **Discuss/consider Lake Mary swim access.** Chairperson Steve Renikow Sr. stated the Town owns 35-40FT of land on the south side of the dock, and it was requested at the annual meeting to use this as a possible swimming access. Several phone calls have been made to determine what the land can be used for, but calls are still being returned. The Congressman was also contacted and is researching if there is any funding that can be used for this project.
  - d. **Discuss/consider Rescue Squad report.** Mike Caylor stated he is on the Board for the Wausaukee Rescue Squad. There are four municipalities on payment contract and rate was determined based on improved parcels within the municipality. When the Town of Wagner was evaluated the total number of improved parcels was considered, but the Wausaukee Rescue Squad only services North of Highway X. South of Highway X is covered by Bay Area Paramedics. After evaluating the area, it was determined the Wausaukee Rescue Squad could respond faster than Bay Area coming from Marinette. The recommendation is to let the Squad service the entire Town since payment is already in the contract. Chairperson Steve Renikow Sr. questioned why it wasn't already that way. Mike Caylor stated it had been set up this way for a long time. The first step would be Chairperson Steve Renikow Sr. attending the Wausaukee Rescue Squad



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Board meeting on May 17<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at 6:00PM and request the coverage. If the Squad agrees then dispatch would need to be contacted to change the computer system. The final step would be to notify Bay Area Paramedics.

- e. Discuss/consider assessor's compensation. Assessor Tom McGuire contacted Chairperson Steve Renikow Sr regarding an increase in price. The current contract is through 2023. If necessary, this will be on the agenda next month.
  - f. Discuss/consider new flag pole for Town Hall. William Everson contacted Chairperson Steve Renikow Sr. regarding funding for the flag pole at Town Hall. He provided a budget and a 5X8FT flag was ordered with a 30FT pole including a light. The lead time is five weeks.
