- 1. Call to order attendance sign in. Mary called meeting to order

-Mark said that all things with Cottage Lane are on schedule, he also contacted Harding portable and was able to change the schedule to save the town \$15 a month, and spoke to Road King in regards to the contract for three years at a rate of 120/hr per truck to \$115/hr per truck which would save the town about \$1050/year

-Ed attended the rescue squad meeting and they are keeping the same budget as last year and they owe \$118,000.00 on a squad yet.

- 9. Budget Adjustments/transfers. a transfer of 100,000.00 from checking to money market

b. Cleaning of town hall

-Margo stated that a volunteer option may work to have this done. -Ed made a motion to pay a cleaning person \$14/hour and Mark second the motion. Margo asked the attendees if they know someone that is interested to contact clerk@tn.wagner.wi.gov

c. Discuss/ consider making an insurance claim for the windshield repair

- Margo told the board that deductible is 250.00 and the cost to repair is 426.67 and the insurance agent recommended not to make a claim on a small amount as it will affect premium in the future.
- Mary motioned to repair truck with out a claim and Ed seconded

d. Sign agreement with Marinette County for Collecting Taxes for the 2023-2024 taxes.

e. Discuss/consider a signing of a board resolution proposing to exceed the allowable levy limit.

-Mark motioned to pass a resolution to exceed the allowable tax levy of .488% to 8.465% which would increase the town levy by 29,229.00 and Ed seconded the motion.

Margo stated the additional monies would be:
\$9086.00 for General Government Expenses
\$14,136.00 for fire and rescue safety
\$6,007.00 for increase recycling and solid waste disposal

f. Set date for a special meeting for increasing the Tax Levy amount with a signed resolution approving to exceed the allowable levy limit(with voting electors)

- Mark made a motion to set the date for Special meeting for the electors to pass the board resolution to raise tax levy to be September 28th at 6pm. at the Town Hall. Ed seconded the motion.

-Mike Caylor told the board that the shoulders on Caylor road are low in spots after the wedging was completed.

-Wojowoski farms stated that Konell Road needs some gravel and more grading during the year

-Mark motioned to close public input Ed seconded it
