## MEETING MINUTES

### MONTHLY TOWN BOARD MEETING

Wednesday, November 11<sup>th</sup>, 2020 6:30 pm

Town of Wagner Town Hall, W2379 County Road JJ, Wausaukee

Attendance: Chairperson Steve Renikow Sr., Supervisors Mollie Arthur and Ed Delfosse, Treasurer Margo Renikow, 5 members of the public and Shirley Prudhomme from the Peshtigo Times. Clerk Cassie Brown was absent.

1. **Call to order – attendance sign in. Called to order by Chairperson Steve Renikow Sr. at 6:30PM.**
2. **Pledge of Allegiance was said.**
3. **Approve agenda. Motion to approve Arthur/Delfosse.**
4. **Correspondence. None.**
5. **Board updates. Chairperson Steve Renikow Sr. requested a moment of silence in respect for all Veterans. The pole workers were thanked for all of their hard work with elections this year. There are 472 registered voters in the Town of Wagner and 438 people voted.**

10. **Fire Department updates. Mike Caylor stated there were two calls in the last month. One for power lines arching and one for a vehicle rollover. 44 hours of training and maintenance were completed. All testing has been completed except for DOT inspections scheduled for February 2021. A gun raffle is scheduled for November 28<sup>th</sup>, 2020 but will be at the Fire Hall instead of the Heritage. This event will be**
